Eligibility/Seeding: USCSA Conference Ski Teams, USSA Seniors, USSA J1, J2, J3. Only **one** Scoring Team from each college is seeded according to coach's discretion. **Individual** competitors (anyone not seeded) will start according to their USSA points. All athletes must have a current USSA License to participate.

Entry Procedure: Each Team Captain must submit one USSA Team Entry Form per gender. Only one team per college is seeded according to coach's discretion.
